



On October 20th, 2023, the Commission Nationale Destination pour Tous awarded the City of Nîmes the silver level of the "Destination Pour Tous" (Destination for Everyone) state label.

Today, eight sites hold the "Tourisme & handicap" label (the Roman monuments, Carré d'art museum, the Musée de la romanité, the Ciel de Nîmes restaurant, the Vertigo youth hostel, the Nîmes Tourism Board), and other players will be encouraged to join the process.






